

Developmental Evaluation

- Developmental evaluation refers to long-term, partnering relationships between evaluators and those engaged in innovative initiatives and development.
- Processes include asking evaluative questions and gathering information to provide feedback and support developmental decision-making and course corrections along the emergent path.
- The evaluator is part of a team whose members collaborate to conceptualize, design and test new approaches in a long-term, on-going process of continuous improvement, adaptation, and intentional change.
- The evaluator's primary function in the team is to elucidate team discussions with evaluative questions, data and logic, and to facilitate data-based assessments and decision-making in the unfolding and developmental processes of innovation.


